CHRISTIAN BRODHAG

Christian BRODHAG is director of research at the Ecole des Mines de Saint-Etienne (France). Civil mining engineer and doctor “es science”, he was Interministerial Delegate for Sustainable Development of the French government from July 2004 to May 2008, responsible in particular for leading the development of the National Strategy for Sustainable Development.

He chaired the Advisory Council of the Institute for Energy and Environment (IEPF) which is the institutional organization of the Francophonie in charge of energy, environment and sustainable development.

He was President of the French Commission on Sustainable Development from 1996 to 1998.

He also chaired the Working Group of the AFNOR (French Agency for Normalization) on Sustainable Development (SD 21000) and represented the state in negotiating the ISO 26000 standard on social responsibility. He continues to follow the negotiations on behalf of the Francophonie (French speaking network for which he chairs the ISO 26000 committee).

He is the author of several books including *The four truths of the world to another civilization* (Editions du Felin, 1994) translated into Spanish and Portuguese and co-author of a dictionary for Sustainable Development (Editions de l'AFNOR, 2004).
